



Directions to Mount Nittany Medical Center in Event/Football Traffic.

**Please follow this plan to get to the Medical Center in urgent situations.
In an emergency, call 911. An ambulance will bring you to the Medical Center.**

The following plan was developed by Mount Nittany Medical Center's Security Department, State College Police Department and the Pennsylvania State University Police Department to assist the public and Medical Center staff accessing the Medical Center during football game weekends.

From State College:

- From College Avenue, turn left on **Puddintown Road** at Confer Auto Sales
- From Puddintown Road, turn left on **Orchard Road**
- From Orchard Road, turn right on **Park Avenue**
- From Park Avenue, turn right on **Hospital Drive**

From Bellefonte:

- From College Avenue, turn right on **Houserville Road** at the traffic light by Sheetz
- From Houserville Road, turn left on **Puddintown Road**
- From Puddintown Road, turn right on **Orchard Road**
- From Orchard Road, turn right on **Park Avenue**
- From Park Avenue, turn right on **Hospital Drive**

From I-99 West:

- From I-99 West, take **322 East exit**
- From 322 East, take **College Avenue exit** and turn right
- From College Avenue, turn right on **Puddintown Road** at Confer Auto Sales
- From Puddintown Road, turn left on **Orchard Road**
- From Orchard Road, turn right on **Park Avenue**
- From Park Avenue, turn right on **Hospital Drive**

From Port Matilda:

- From 322 East, take **College Avenue exit** and turn right
- From College Avenue, turn right on **Puddintown Road** at Confer Auto Sales
- From Puddintown Road, turn left on **Orchard Road**
- From Orchard Road, turn right on **Park Avenue**
- From Park Avenue, turn right on **Hospital Drive**

Police will not permit traffic on Orchard Road to get backed up at the Park Avenue stop sign. All traffic will be directed onto Park Avenue toward the Medical Center.

If you have traffic problems somewhere other than Orchard Road and you have a cell phone, call 911. Give your name, exact location, destination (Medical Center), make, model, and color of your vehicle. If possible, a police officer will be sent to escort you to the Medical Center. When you see the police officer, get out of your car and wave so that he/she can identify you. Please use this privilege in extreme emergencies only.
